Example: if a student played four years of football that would be 5+5+5+5=20; a score of 20 is worth 3 total points.

This includes off season training for 15 hours or more per week during the academic school year. For example, training 15 hours per week for basketball throughout the spring sports season is equivalent to an activity. Signature of adult supervisor, excluding parent, is required.

Work / Volunteer Experience (4 Year Total) Total Hours:
