

Qualifications of Applicants for the Dover Mothers' Club Scholarship

Recipience of Scholarship

The student with the most accumulated points based on the point system described below will be awarded the scholarship.

Using a POINT SYSTEM:

40% Academic + 20% Activities + 16% Work/Volunteer + 12% Character + 12% Members = 100%

Academic: GPA

3.00 - 3.09	3 points
3.10 - 3.19	7 points
3.20 - 3.29	10 points
3.30 - 3.39	14 points
3.40 - 3.49	17 points
3.50 - 3.59	21 points
3.60 - 3.69	24 points
3.70 - 3.79	28 points
3.80 - 3.89	32 points
3.90 - 3.99	36 points
4.00 & UP	40 points

Character (based on 250 word written response)

.....	12 points
.....	9 points
.....	7 points
.....	4 points
.....	2 points

Activities: 5 points per year per activity

0 - 20	3 points
21 - 40	6 points
41 - 60	10 points
61 - 80	13 points
81 - 100	16 points
100 & UP	20 points

Example: if a student played four years of football that would be $5+5+5+5=20$; a score of 20 is worth 3 total points.

This includes off season training for 15 hours or more per week during the academic school year. For example, training 15 hours per week for basketball throughout the spring sports season is equivalent to an activity. Signature of adult supervisor, excluding parent, is required.

Work / Volunteer Experience (4 Year Total)

Total Hours:

25 hours	1 point
26 - 50 hours	2 points
51 - 75 hours	3 points
76 - 100 hours	4 points
101 - 125 hours	5 points
126 - 150 hours	7 points
151 - 175 hours	9 points

Example: If a student has 345 work / volunteer hours, their score would be 15 points.

an applicant cannot score above 25 points in this section

5 years	10 points
6 years	12 points

*1 year membership = attend 50% of the meetings in the academic school year
